Additional Costuming:

1st Grade—may wear a pair of mittens/gloves if they choose

2nd Grade:

- **Melton, Mama, Papa, and Santa**—Mrs. Berger will have these costumes
- **Children**—bring own pair of mittens/gloves

- **Elves**—students should bring own mittens/gloves, Mrs. Berger will have a hat for the elves
 - **Reindeer/Rudolph**—Mrs. Berger will have antlers
 - **Doctor**—Mrs. Berger will have a lab coat & stethoscope
 - **Scrooge**—student should bring own gloves, Mrs. Berger will have a scarf & a top hat
