### <u>JEFFERSON MASCOT AND COLORS</u>

Our mascot is the Patriot, as shown on the sign mounted on a gym wall. This wood sign was constructed in the 1980's in front of the school building and was the first to identify the school as Jefferson School by Principal Allan Larocco. Up until then, the school's only labeling was Morton Grade School, the original lettering on the building when the school was built in 1928. The lighted sign was purchased by the PTO and installed in 1999. The school colors are red, white, and blue.
