Youth Tumbling

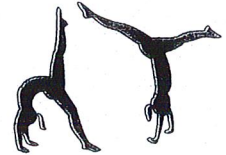

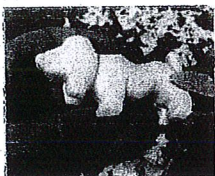
Christmas Stocking Sewing Class
