Dear Patriot Families.

As you know, our school community has been grieving the loss of one of our own, Mrs. Margaret Shafer. Mrs. Shafer taught at Jefferson School for nearly 30 years, from 1991-2020, and was a teacher in Morton CUSD 709 for over 38 years. She taught countless students as a special education, first grade, and most recently, third grade teacher. Mrs Shafer retired from her extensive teaching career in December 2020 after being diagnosed with ALS.

ALS is a progressive neurodegenerative disease that affects nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord. ALS - Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis - affects everyone differently. Our brain tells our muscles how and when to move. Individuals diagnosed with ALS do not receive these messages from the brain, which affects the individuals' ability to speak and eat. Every 90 minutes, someone is diagnosed with ALS and unfortunately, there is no cure for ALS.
